## *Day 1*

Starting around 8:30 after your breakfast at your hotel we will take you to the port where we embark for our adventure through the Negro River. Such river that enables the greatest number of activities and has incomparable beauty and great advantage by having a low incidence of mosquitoes.

The tour starts passing through the border of Manaus (Rio Negro bridge, neighborhoods, historic center, tourism port, Adolfo Lisboa market, industrial port of Manaus, Ponta Negra beach etc.), we arrive at the Meeting of the Rivers Negro and Solimões (the meeting the Amazon River waters) we will stop for explanations of its features, curiosity and photos.

We will continue our adventure sailing a little the Amazon River around 2 hours to the ecological park lake January, where we stop for our lunch and other activities in the area, along the way we will pass through several villages with different characteristics, their constructions are made on “stilts” (houses built on tall poles fixed to the ground). Or on driftwood logs. On this part of the tour we will know the Igapó (forest area that floods during part of the year) walking by a suspended wooden walkway that leads to the lake of Water Lilies (giant aquatic plants) or if the season allows we will have the chance to see and interact with animals free in the nature as monkeys, sloths, birds and others, if at the time the forest is partially flooded will have the opportunity to enjoy the small paths through the forest or walk to get to know the Samaúma tree (a giant species) in this biome that presents so different and then return for a delicious lunch at the boat.



## *Day 2*

In the morning explore this area in search of wildlife and piranha fishing. After lunch we will go to the Lake Acajatuba, where we meet a family and have a fantastic experience and the privilege to enter the water and interact with pink dolphins, sweet and playful animals that after centuries involved in legends and Amazonian tales arouse certain respect, fear and distance among some of these traditional communities but unfortunately come to be hunted by some fishermen without scruples who kill them for use as fish bait (piracatinga)! or killed when they tear the nets of some fishermen.

We will know at this location a project supervised by government agencies that authorize them to develop activity in a sustainable way for interaction in the natural environment within the standards established by them, and it gives us this unforgettable experience of being able to enter the water and interact with these animals that live free in the nature, as we enter the water and follow the handler while he's feeding them. In this site we also will see the fish Arapaima, you'll have a unique experience, the opportunity to feed with a bait (biggest fish in freshwater with scales in the world), using a stick, string and a small bait, but without using a hook, you'll feel this excitement without hurting the fish.

Then we continue the ride to where we meet another Caboclo's family that have near their home several fruit trees like the palm of Acai and Brazil nut, but most of all, we'll get to know a "manioc flour house" where we know the craft for manioc flour production and even taste a traditional "tapioquina" with coffee. Then return to the boat to get ready because at night we will leave on our small boat for alligator spotting and observing the nightlife before dinner.



## Day 3

Early departure to trek through a trail where we can feel a little more of an experience to walk among the trees and meet several species with the possibility to find some animals on the way where our guide will explain about life in the forest, plants and show some survival techniques. Then we return to the boat.

On the return we will leave for the other side of the Rio Negro we can observe the first islands in the famous archipelago of Anavilhanas, the largest river archipelago in the world. We will visit an indigenous community to meet part of their way of life, attend a presentation of their rituals, using musical instruments and traditional dances of their culture and also see their crafts. This community is native from the uttermost parts of the upper Rio Negro in the Amazon, on the border with Colombia, they will tell of their history and legends in a large gathering that still holds great surprises.


Heading towards Manaus we will visit the Tarumã-Mirim where you can have a dip in the history of the golden age of rubber, we will make a visit to Seringal Museum “Vila Paraíso” a special place where you will feel back in time and know a little of that time, so important to our history and can better understand how was the development of the city of Manaus (the museum is closed on Monday, in which case we stop for a delicious swim in the beautiful Tupe beach).

We end our tour, with arrival estimated to the marine around 5pm, and depending on our tour time, weather conditions, river level regime we can also enjoy beaches, you can register in photos and videos, but mostly in your memories an incredible day that will never be forgotten and will also make sure to share with all people as do all our other customers who also enjoy this Ecological Adventure in the Amazon.





# Cichla Ocellaris



Our boat was built in the city of Novo Airão, is the result of experience and work with tourism in the Amazon. The boat already had changes in these last years such as raising the hull and number of cabins. The name “Cichla Ocellaris” was chosen by the first owner because of his passion for fishing, especially Peacock Bass (translation of the scientific name: *Cichla ocellaris*).

The ship have been equipped with kitchen, solarium, laundry, library, restaurant, sonar, GPS and other necessary equipments to a safe journey.

1. **Main Deck** - 6 acclimatized cabins with private facilities, bunk beds and reading lights. 4 cabins in the front and 2 in the back. Galley and entrance hall.
2. **Second Deck** - 2 acclimatized cabins with private facilities, bunk beds and reading lights. Bar/restaurant/conference room. Library. Wheelhouse. Balcony at the back.
3. **Upper Deck** - open deck for sunbathing, stargazing or observation. Barbecue place.

2. From 8 guests or more, the cabins can be shared. There could be 2 people in them. Private cabins, please, ask for our value.
3. Children 0 to 5 years free (one per family).
4. Children 6-10 years pay 50% only (one per family).
5. We request a 10% deposit for making your reservation, the balance can be paid during the tour.
6. We do not return the value of the deposit.

### WHAT TO BRING ALONG:

Light clothes, bathing suit, long-sleeved shirt, long pants and closed shoes for walking in the jungle, hat, mosquito repellent and sunscreen.
